**ANNUAL DUES**

Our annual dues for the 2019-2020 budget will remain **unchanged** for the 13th year in a row.

**BY LAWS**

Attached are the Board approved By Laws for approval by the Membership. These By Laws were sent out in January and we received feedback from Members and have incorporated many of those suggestions. The attorney for the Association has reviewed the By Laws.

**DEER REDUCTION PROGRAM**

The deer reduction program was initiated in October 2018 and ended January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2019. We will be voting as a membership whether or not to continue this program. If the program is approved, we have the potential to receive grant money from the Indiana Department of Natural Resources to defray the cost.

**BEACH SECURITY**

Midwest Security Services will be providing our beach security this year and will be checking beach tags at the Stops. Please have your beach tags with your group.

**DUNE RESTORATION**

Our fore dune and beach are our greatest asset. On June 1<sup>st</sup> from 9 AM to noon, we need volunteers to assist with beach cleanup and removing invasive species. Meet at Stop 35.

**FIREWORKS**

Indiana State Law allows fireworks on a homeowner's property and only during a 10 day period around the 4<sup>th</sup> of July. Fireworks are banned on the beach, the park and all roads in Duneland Beach.

**GARBAGE REMOVAL AND RECYCLE**

Garbage pickup will be once a week all year long. Recycle pick up will be once a week from Memorial Day thru Labor Day. During the remainder of the year, recycle pick up will be every other week. Please see the attached flier describing appropriate recyclable materials.



### **WATER**

If you have an in ground irrigation system and/or a swimming pool the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) requires that the system be protected against accidental backflow of untreated water back into the drinking water system. The device to prevent backflow must be tested annually. We have received feedback from 23 Members but we know that there are many more Members that have irrigation systems or swimming pools who have not complied with our request for information.
